## NPUC Student Acceleration Policy & Request Form

## Criteria for acceleration of an elementary student are to be based on the following minimal requirements:

- 1. The student is expected to have a score which places him at the 90th percentile or above in each area of a standardized achievement test and to have satisfactorily met the objectives in the Curriculum Guide in the basic area -- reading, mathematics and language skills -- at the grade preceding the one to which the student is to advance. This evaluation is to be made by the teacher in consultation with the conference office of education.
- 2. This student must demonstrate satisfactorily evidence of emotional and social readiness for acceleration.
- 3. Teachers should not initiate a program for acceleration of a student (i.e. two years in one, or three years in two) before submitting a request to the local conference office of education.
- 4. Ordinarily, students at the elementary level should be limited to one acceleration experience. (See NPUC Handbook for Teachers)
